RE: Neeser Construction Letter of Recommendation

To Whom It May Concern:

Neeser Construction Inc. recently completed work for the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium's (ANTHC's) Hybrid Operating Room project at the Alaska Native Medical Center (ANMC). ANMC is Alaska's only Level II Trauma Center and the Hybrid Operating Room improves trauma care for Alaska Native people, as well as all residents in the state of Alaska.

The Hybrid OR is one of the more technologically advanced projects ANTHC has undertaken. It combined a modern OR as well as an interventional radiography suite, which is used for performing vascular procedures. These procedures include inserting a catheter into a blood vessel in the groin or wrist; threading the catheter using advanced imaging; and treating vascular disease or trauma.

The technical expertise that Neeser Construction brought to this project was instrumental in assuring the project was completed on time and within budget. Neeser's contract was for "design assist" services whereby they provided assistance during the design phase in identifying alternative materials and methods and ordering long lead items that ultimately lowered the overall cost and time of the project. Their coordination efforts during the design and construction phases, not only with their subcontractors but with ANTHC's numerous vendors of medical equipment, significantly contributed to the smooth integration of the final assembly; all while working in a operational hospital and surgery suite.
